Well after last board meeting, "don't lose site of the big picture" kept popping back up in my mind and I realized that this club needs some long term goals, some, "pie in the sky ideas" that gets people motivated and pulling their resources and energy in the same direction.

The board has moved in that direction by setting aside 35% of the current account balance into a "Runway" fund and directing that 35% of all new income shall also be moved into the "Runway" fund.
